Insurgents at Erivan sacked and burned four Armenian villages.

Cossacks subsequently inflicted enormous losses, capturing 900 of the insurgents.

The leaders of the movement were executed.

Many other Armenian villages have been surrounded. At Badambu 800 Christians were compelled to embrace Islamism. Many women were outraged in the presence of their husbands and sons. Thirty-seven men were beheaded in the presence of their wives and children.
